## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of reserved posts for SCs/STs and OBCs vacant as on date;
(b) the reasons for not filling these posts; and
(c) the steps taken by the Railways to fill up these vacancies?

## Answer

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS( DR. R. VELU )

(a): The number of vacant posts on Indian Railways as on date is around 1.7 lacs including 32646 posts reserved for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
(b): Filling up the vacancies of reserved as well as unreserved posts is a continuous process. Some vacancies always remain due to non-availability of eligible empanelled candidates in the recruitment and promotional grades.
(c): Indents have been placed to Railway Recruitment Boards to fill up Group ' C ' vacancies and Railway Recruitment Cells to fill up Group ' $D$ ' vacancies. Wherever eligible candidates to fill up promotional vacancies are not there, the posts are diverted to the recruitment grades and filled up by direct recruitment from open market.
