- (a): 41 new line projects and 20 gauge conversion projects have been included in the Railway Budgets during the last three years and current year which mainly cover backward, rural and under-developed regions of the country. Surveys for 175 new line and 20 gauge conversion projects have been taken up during the same period.
- (b): The projects are in various stages of progress as per the availability of funds. None of the projects has been fully completed out of these projects.
- (c): The project-wise details of the funds allocated and expenditure incurred is available in Railway Budget documents. State-wise expenditure is not maintained.
- (d): The projects are progressing as per the availability of funds. No time frame is feasible to be given.
