- (a) whether a decision has been taken to discontinue the Pulgaon-Arvi (Shakuntala) train service running since British times;
- (b) if so, the reasons for discontinuing the said train;
- (c) whether the Railways have received representations from the State Government and other organizations in this regard to reintroduce the Pulgaon-Arvi train in view of its importance for the local people; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Railways thereto?

Answer

- (a) & (b) No,Sir.However, 643/644 Pulgaon-Arvi Passenger is temporarily cancelled from 30.7.2008 as a safety measure due to track being unsafe.
- (c) & (d) No representation has been received from State Government. However, a representation from Shri Baba Abdul Jamil, State Secretary, Maharashtra Pradesh Samajwadi Party has been received in this regard. Restoration of 643/644 Pulgaon-Arvi Passenger has not been found feasible at present.
