- (b) The number of Scientists/Engineers who have left ISRO during the last four years are as follows:

- (c)The Government has approved the recommendations of the VI Central Pay Commission and the pay and allowances for Scientists/Engineers have been improved.A special compensationpackage for ISRO scientists/engineers, developed with an objective of attracting and retaining the best young minds of the county, is under review.
- (d) The Scientists/Engineers vacancies arising due to attrition in ISRO are being filled by ISRO Centralised Recruitment Board annually.
