- (a) whether re-structuring of Central Secretariat Service (CSS) and Central Secretariat Stenographers Service (CSSS) requires different yard sticks for cadre restructuring;
- (b) if so,the details thereof;
- (c) the remedial measures taken by the Government to remove the stagnation;and
- (d) the reasons for non-inclusion of CSSS cadre in cadre re-structuring?

(a) to (d): The cadre restructuring of the CSS and CSSS is an ongoing process. The last cadre restructuring of the CSS took place in 2003. A Committee for cadre restructuring of CSS has been constituted on 16.06.2008 to assess the magnitude of stagnation of various grades of the CSS, review the structure of the feeder cadre, and suggest the remedial measures for career progression of the CSS officers at various levels.

The cadre restructuring of the CSSS was taken up last in 2005.
