(a) to (c): The Government is seized of the problem of cross border infiltration on the Indo-Bangladesh and Indo-Pakistan borders. There is no significant incidence of infiltration on the other borders.

The Government have adopted a multi-pronged approach to contain cross-border infiltration which, inter-alia, includes round the clock surveillance & patrolling on the borders and establishment of observation posts; construction of border fencing and flood lighting; introduction of modern and hi-tech surveillance equipment; ugradation of intelligence set up and coordination with the State Governments and concerned intelligence agencies.
