(a)to (c): The Central Government has issued a direction to the University Grants Commission under Section 20(1) of the University Grants Commission Act,1956,to frame regulations,inter-alia,making the qualification of National Eligibility Test/State Level Eligibility Test (NET/SLET) compulsory for appointment of teachers at entry level in the universities and colleges,with relaxation only for those who acquire Ph.D. degree from a university complying with the UGC regulations regarding registration,course work and evaluation process.
