(a) to (c): The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the Kaladan Multi-Modal Transit Transport Project was prepared by RITES in the year 2003. The Kaladan Project envisages connectivity between Indian Ports on the eastern seaboards and Sittwe Port in Myanmar and then through riverine transport and by road to Mizoram. This project will provide an alternate route for transportation of goods to the North-Eastern States of India.
