ASSISTANCE FROM WORLD BANK FOR MILK PRODUCTION

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposal seeking assistance from the Government and World Bank for increasing the production of milk as to bridge the gap between demand and supply of milk in the National Capital Territory of Delhi during the last three years;
- (b) the present status of those proposals; and
- (c) the time by which these proposals are likely to be finalized?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI TASLIMUDDIN)

(a) to (c) The Government has neither received any report on the gap between demand and supply of milk nor any proposal seeking assistance from the government and World Bank for increasing the production of milk to bridge the gap in the National Capital Territory of Delhi during the last three years. However, National Dairy Development Board has submitted a project proposal on increasing the milk production over the next 15 years, with the Government's and the World Bank's assistance in the entire country. It is at a preliminary stage of formulation.
