(a)to(c) The Government has neither received any report on the gap between demand and supply of milk nor nay proposal seeking assistance from the government and W orld Bank for increasing the production of milk to bridge the gap in the National Capital Territory of Delhi during the last three years. However, National Dairy Development Board has submitted a project proposal on increasing the milk production over the next 15 years, with the Government's and the World Bank's assistance in the entire country. It is at a preliminary stage of formulation.
