- (a) the number of ongoing/sanctioned Road over bridges (ROBs) in Kerala which are not completed/started due to the non availability of funds from the Railways;
- (b) if so,the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Railways to expedite the said projects?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (DR.R.VELU)

(a) to (c) All the works of ROBs (Road Over Bridges) sanctioned on cost sharing basis falling in Kerala State are at different stages of progress. However, work is held up at 32 sites due to non-finalization of tenders/want of estimate/Land acquisition form State Government. In another 4 cases General Arrangement Drawing have to be approved by State Govt. and in 9 works alignment details are awaited from State Govt. No work is held up for want of funds from Railway's side.
