(a) & (b) No land acquisition is needed in respect of future nuclear power projects which are planned as expansion projects at existing sites viz. Kakrapar (Gujarat), Rawatbhata (Rajasthan) and Kudankulam (Tamil Nadu). Jaitapur (Maharashtra) is a new site needing about 700 hectares of land for the nuclear plant and its exclusion zone. Land acquisition process for this project has started.
