(a) & (b) The British Foreign Secretary Mr. David Miliband was on an official visit to India from 13-16 January,2009. The visit was part of the annual bilateral dialogue held at the level of Foreign Ministers. The two sides held extensive discussions on bilateral, regional and multilateral issues of mutual interest. No agreement was signed during the visit.
