## Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to formulate a National Consumer Policy;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard; and
- (c) the steps taken to enhance the effectiveness of working of Central Consumer Protection Council?

## **Answer**

- (a) & (b): Yes sir. The Central Government has constituted a Working group on 26.2.2004 under the Chairpersonship of Principal Secretary, Co-operation, Food & Consumer Protection, Government of Tamil Nadu. The Committee consists of Secretary in charge of Consumer Affairs, to the Govt. of States of Jammu & Kashmir, Tripura, Andhra Pradesh, Rajashthan and representatives of Voluntary Consumer Organisations. The working group has already started its consultations and it is yet to finalise its recommendations on National Consumer Policy.
- (c) After the receipt of recommendations of the working group, any action required in this regard will be taken.
