DEVELOPMENT OF CITIES IN ANDHRA PRADESH

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Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the schemes proposed for the development of various cities of Andhra Pradesh alongwith the amount allocated for the purpose during this year;
- (b) whether the Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted any proposal in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the decisions being taken in this regard;
- (d) whether the World Bank is providing any financial assistance for this purpose; and
- (e) if so, the project-wise details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI GHULAM NABIAZAD)

(a)to(c): (i) Under the IDSMT Scheme, Central assistance of Rs.1717.00 lakh has been tentatively allocated during 2004-05 for development of towns of Andhra Pradesh. Till 21.2.2005, Government of Andhra Pradesh have submitted proposals in respect of ongoing projects in 10 towns and new projects in 17 towns, and Central assistance of Rs.456.11 lakh has been released for ongoing projects in 3 towns and new projects in 6 towns. Townwise details of proposals received and Central assistance released are given in the Annexure I. Proposals in respect of 7 ongoing project towns (sl.nos.10 to 16 of annexure) are under consideration. Proposals for releasing Central assistance for 9 new project towns (sl.nos.17 to 25 of annexure) approved by the State Level Sanctioning Committee have also been received on 11.2.2005 and would be considered, subject to the proposals conforming to the Scheme guidelines.

(ii) Under Mega City Scheme, projects are sanctioned in accordance with the guidelines given by the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC). As per information available, 224 projects in Hyderabad have been sanctioned by the SLSC so far at an estimated cost of Rs.2067.05 crore out of which 104 projects have been completed, 62 projects are in progress and work on 58 projects is yet to commence. Central share of Rs. 198.31 crore has been released to Hyderabad Mega City since inception of the scheme till 2003-04. During 2004-05, the entire amount of Rs.43,10,20,000/-, earmarked for Hyderabad Mega City, has been released.

(iii) Under AUWSP, the allocation earmarked for the year 2004-05 in respect of Andhra Pradesh is Rs.470.10 lakh. Detailed Project Reports of 20 towns have been received during 2004-05. Projects in these 20 towns have been sanctioned. Names of these 20 towns, project cost, etc. are given in Annexure II.

(iv) A new Centrally sponsored Scheme of Solid Waste Management and Drainage in 10 Selected IAF Airfield Towns including Dundigal in Andhra Pradesh has been approved by Government in October, 2003 for implementation at an estimated cost of Rs.99.34 crore. Necessary provision of funds has been made for this scheme in the 10th Five Year Plan. State Government is yet to identify suitable land for the scheme in Dundigal with clearances of the State Pollution Control Board and IAF authorities.

(d)&(e): As per information available, World Bank is engaged in advance preparation of the proposed Andhra Pradesh Urban Reform and Municipal Services Project. The project would address Urban Reforms, upgrading poor areas and infrastructure for linking slums in city networks and city wide infrastructure in a phased manner.

In December, 2004, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has forwarded a brief note on proposed Hyderabad Metropolitan Water Supply & Sewerage Project at an estimated cost of Rs.2000 crore with a request to explore the possibility of getting financial assistance from the World Bank. This was examined and the Ministry's comments were sent to the State Government in January, 2005 for compliance. Response of the State Government is awaited.
