- (a) whether the Union Government has achieved the target with regard to poverty alleviation;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the main reasons for the same;
- (d) the total amount spent by various States particularly by Karnataka during each of the last three years till date for this purpose, State-wise;
- (e) whether the Union Government is considering to establish a specialised National Bank for self-employment of urban unemployed in the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN EMPLOYMENT & POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA)

(a)to(c): In order to alleviate the urban poverty, Ministry of Urban Employment and Poverty Alleviation is implementing on all India basis, a centrally sponsored scheme namely Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY), with effect from 1.12.1997. This Programme is specially meant for urban poor living below poverty line and seeks to provide gainful employment to the urban unemployed or underemployed poor through (i) encouragement to setting up of self employment ventures by the urban poor and (ii) through provision of wage employment by utilizing their labour for construction of socially and economically useful public assets. During the 9th Five Year Plan, no physical targets were prescribed under the Scheme and this was left to be decided by the States/UTs as per their needs. However, in the 10th Five Year Plan, target for setting up of 4 lakhs micro-enterprises and skill upgradation of 5 lakh Below Poverty

Line persons have been fixed. During the first three years of the 10th Plan the Targets/Achievements on annual basis is as under:-
