- (a) whether Libya has opened its doors for import of Indian tea;
- (b) if so, the details of total export of tea from India prior to levy of ban by Libya; and
- (c) total tea likely to be exported to Libya this year?

Answer

- (a): Yes Sir.
- (b): No tea was exported from India to Libya during 2001-02 to 2003-04 in view of a dispute which arose on the quality of tea exported to Libya during 2000-01. Details of tea exports to Libya prior to 2001-02 are given below:

(c): According to available information, contracts have been signed for export of 3 million kgs of tea to Libya during 2004-05.
