(a) whether there are any capacity constraints faced by the BSNL in releasing the pre-paid SIM cards to meet the entire present demand by the customers;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government has received any complaints about such scarcity leading to the widespread corruption in the BSNL in distributing pre-paid cards to the customers; and

(d) if so, the steps proposed to be taken by the Government to tackle the problem of scarcity of SIM cards?
