**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of proposals received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh to improve National Highway No.7 and the action being taken in this regard;
- (b) the time frame for providing sanctions to these proposals;
- (c) the total number of proposals received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh to improve National Highway Nos.12A and 27; and
- (d) the action taken in this regard so far and the time by which sanction is likely to be provided to these proposals?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a)&(b): 6 no. of proposals for improvement of NH-7 amounting to Rs.13.32 crores have been received from State Government of Madhya Pradesh during the current Annual Plan 2004-05. This Ministry has sanctioned all the proposals received.

(c)&(d): 8 no. of proposals amounting to Rs.22.09 crores have so far been received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh for improvement of NH-12A and NH-27 during the current Annual Plan 2004-05, out of which 7 proposals amounting to Rs.18.45 crores have been sanctioned. The remaining one proposal is under examination and its sanction will depend on the acceptability with regard to the technical parameters/guidelines of the Ministry.
