1) Uttaranchal 2) Sikkim 3) Maharashtra 4) Karnataka 5) Tamilnadu

(ii) Other steps taken by Agricultural & Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) include financial assistance for setting up of flower auction centers at Bangalore, Mumbai and Noida (Uttar Pradesh), cold storage facilities to handle perishable cargo and transport assistance to exporters.

(c) APEDA has extended financial assistance for a feasibility study for development of floriculture, in the State of Jammu & Kashmir, for exports.
