(a), (b)&(c): An amount of Rs.26.21 crore has been provided to Chattishgarh during 2001-02 to 2003-04 under various non-conventional energy programmes/ schemes for setting up biogas plants, remote village electrification projects, solar pumps, SPV street lights, SPV home lighting systems, small hydro power plants and biomass gasifier systems. The non-conventional energy programmes / schemes are being implemented by Chattishgarh Renewable Development Agency (CREDA), Raipur. No proposal is pending for clearance with the Ministry.
