(c) whether our Police Forces and Armed Forces have been imparted basic lessons on Human Right;

(d) if so, the ways it is being done; and

(e) if not the reasons therefor?

(a),(b),(c),(d)&(e): Appropriate training courses for the Police and Para-Military Forces to enable them to deal with terrorists are run in the training facilities of the Central and State Governments using latest training equipment and methodology. The Army being deployed in the North-East and Jammu & Kashmir are also adequately trained and regularly updated on terrorist tactics and modus operandi. Sensitization to Human Rights is an integral part of the basic courses run for these personnel.
