CONSTRUCTION OF OVER-BRIDGES AT JHARGRAM

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any proposal for construction of a overbridge at Jhargram of South Eastern Railway is pending with the Railway Ministry;
- (b) if so, since when it is pending; and
- (c) the time by which the decision is likely to be taken?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R.VELU)

(a)to(c) No, Sir. No fresh proposal is pending with Railway. However, the work for construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) in lieu of an existing level crossing at Km.153/31-154/1 at Jhargram was sanctioned in 2001-02, on cost sharing basis with State Government. Railway portion of work (Bridge proper across the Railway track) shall be executed by Railway and approaches by State Government. General Arrangement Drawing has been approved by Railway. Estimate for approach portion and acceptance of some standard stipulations are still awaited from State Government.
