- (a) & (b): Some existing contracts of STD/ISD/PCO booths are going to expire on 27.4.2005 after which these booths would be allotted to various categories of persons as per existing guidelines.
- (c): Yes, Sir.
- (d) & (e): Instructions have been issued on 11.3.2005 that the physically handicapped persons who are presently running STD/ISD/PCO booths at railway stations and whose contracts are expiring may be allowed to continue and their contract may be extended after expiry upto 27.4.2007 provided their working is satisfactory.
