Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has fixed any timeframe to complete the Ghatkopar Road Over Bridge in Mumbai;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to reopen the old Railway Overshed Bridge opposite Jhunjhunwala College in Ghatkopar after the same is repaired; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRIR. VELU)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Rebuilding of existing Road Over Bridge is in progress and the work is likely to be completed by March 2006.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Sir. Foot Over Bridge (FOB) belongs to Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) and BMC has deposited a sum of Rs.12.0 lakh with Railways for repair of the FOB for which finalization of executing agency is in progress. The repair work would be completed in a period of 6 months after finalization of agency.
