(a) to (e): The Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has constituted an Inter-Ministerial Task Force in January, 2005 under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary in the Ministry to look into all aspects of implementation of the ethanol-blended petrol programme.

The Task Force is required to meet as often as necessary and apprise the Government on the progress of the ethanol-blended petrol programme. Being of a continuous nature, the Task Force is not envisaged to submit any one-time report to Government.
