(a) to (c) Some meetings with the World Banks officials have been held to discuss the principle of cluster development.

(d) & (e) The Ministry of Rural Development has allocated Rs. 80.00 crore to Council for Advancement of People's Action and Rural Technology (CAPART), a registered society under the aegis of the Ministry, for the year 2004-2005 under the Head 'Assistance to CAPART' which are to be utilized for funding the projects of eligible Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) in the country. No Statewise allocations are made and NGOs are sanctioned funds on project-to-project basis.

(f) The projects are at various stages of implementation and it is difficult to quantify achievements of these projects at this stage.
