(a) to (d): The CBI conducted raids throughout the country under a special drive on 2.2.2005 to target identified persons/ firms of doubtful integrity and involved in specified areas of corruption. Searches were conducted at 251 places all over the country and 70 cases were registered against 119 public servants and 71 private persons/firms. Their involvement or otherwise can only be established at the conclusion of the investigation.
