(a) to (c): A representation from Tamil Nadu Freedom Fighters` Samiti for renaming of Tiruppur Railway Station as `Tiruppur Kumaran Railway Station` was forwarded by the Ministry of Railways for consideration of Ministry of Home Affairs. The said representation has been sent to Government of Tamil Nadu to submit a self-contained proposal with all relevant details as per extant guidelines regarding change in the names of villages, towns, railway stations, etc.

The Union Government has not received any proposal for renaming the Railway Station at Sankagiri Fort as Tyiyagi Dheeran Chinnamalai Railway Station.
