- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) to(d): On the basis of the inter-ministerial task force headed by Dr. B.L.Mungekar, 338 cities/ towns having a substantial minority population were identified and action has been taken to improve civic amenities and to increase the economic opportunities by giving priority in locating existing schemes/ programmes in these cities/ towns. These include opening of new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), upgradation of existing ITIs, Basic Service to Urban Poor (BSUP), Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP), Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMTs), National Rural Health Mission and Urban Health Mission, opening of new branches of Public Sector Banks and improving the flow of credit to minorities.
