## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT(SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) Yes sir,The Government of India commissioned a.study in 2006-07 on teacher attendance in primary and upper primary schools in 19 major States and NCT of Delhi.According to this study, the average attendance rate for teachers was $81.7 \%$ in primary schools and $80.5 \%$ in upper primary schools.
(b) Statement showing State-wise attendance rate is annexed.
(c) The Framework for Implementation of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) was amended in November, 2006 to provide for a greater role of Panchayati Raj bodies in the supervision and monitoring of schools, including teacher attendance.
