(a): As on date 148 Assaying and Hallmarking Centres recognized by Bureau of Indian Standards are operational in the country. State-wise details of these centres are as under:

(b) to (d): Assaying and Hallmarking Centres are set up by entrepreneurs, based on their commercial judgment. With a view to encourage entrepreneurs to set up more such centres in different parts of the country, the Government is operating a scheme under which financial assistance of 15% of the cost of machinery and equipment, subject to a maximum of Rs. 15 lakhs per centre is extended. The assistance for setting up of such centres in North-Eastern region, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and rural areas in the country is 30% of cost of machinery and equipment, subject to maximum of Rs.30 lakhs per centre.
