MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE(SHRI S.S. PALANIMANICKAM)

(a): No, Sir. However, to enable students from economically weaker sections to access higher education, it is proposed to introduce a scheme to provide them foil interest subsidy during the period of moratorium.

And in order to stimulate demand for credit for housing in the middle and lower income segment of population in the country, the Government of India has proposed an interest subvention of i percent on ail individual housing loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, provided the cost of the unit does not exceed Rs.20 lakh.
