(a) to (d):- A Special Recruitment Drive has been launched in November, 2008 to fill up backlog vacancies of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC). As per information received upto 3.7.2009 from 11 Ministries/Departments, there were 207, 177, 397 backlog vacancies of SCs, STs and OBCs respectively as on 1.11.2008.
