## **Answer**

- (a) & (b): Yes. A few representations have been received in respect of the Padma awards announced this year.
- (c) & (d): Padma awards are considered in terms of existing guidelines and conferred after observance of established procedures. As per extant guidelines/regulations, all nominations are placed before the Padma Awards Committee. A due diligence exercise including verification by premier investigating/intelligence agencies of the Government, is undertaken in respect of persons shortlisted by the Padma Awards Committee before announcement of the final list of names. This year also, all prescribed procedures were duly followed before announcement of the names on the occasion of Republic Day, 2010.
