- (a) & (b) Some representations have been received including one from Shri Rajender Singh, Chairperson, Jalbiradari against granting environmental clearance to the Athirappally Hydroelectric project, Kerala on the plea that primitive Kedar tribes culture will be threatened and biodiversity of the area will be affected. Based on the representations, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB) and KSEB has been directed to stop the work on the project till a view on the representations is taken.
- (c) The Environmental Clearance has already been accorded to this project on 18.07.2007.
