(a) to (c) In natural forests, diseases occur as a part of evolution process. In plantations, however, all efforts are taken for prevention and control of common diseases. The Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education and its research institutes have developed prevention and control methods against common diseases of economically important species such as Sal, Shisham, Teak, Eucalyptus, Poplar, Acacia and others. Using these methods and technologies for protection of plantations is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State/UT Forest Departments. The Central Government does not have any separate scheme for this purpose.
