(a), (b), (c) and (d) The operational guidelines of the National Afforestation Programme provides for a multilevel monitoring and evaluation mechanism. On approval of the proposals received from the states, the first installment of the funds sanctioned, is released to the Forest Development Agencies which are the implementing agencies. The second and subsequent installments are released subject to the receipt of reports like annual progress report, quarterly progress report, utilisation certificate, evaluation report and audit report which the agencies are required to submit periodically. Apart from the monitoring and evaluation undertaken by the States, the ministry commissions independent evaluation of the projects through reputed experts and organizations. Besides, the State Level Coordination Committee and the National Level Steering Committee also monitor the implementation of the programme at the state and national level respectively.
