- (a) whether the Government has made any negotiations with the Saudi Government to allow the continued use of Indian Passports instead of the special passport for Haj; and
- (b) if so, the outcome thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SHASHI THAROOR)

(a) & (b) Yes. The Indian Haj pilgrims will be travelling on Indian passports only. Those who are not in possession of valid Indian passports will be issued special limited-validity passports for the purpose of Haj travel alone, which will expire after eight months. The previous system of "Haj Passes" has been discontinued by the Saudi Government.
