- (a) & (b): A Consultant has been engaged for pre-feasibility study for High Speed Rail Corridor between Pune-Mumbai-Ahmedabad. The study is going on and the Consultant has not yet submitted the final report.
- (c): The other corridors selected for prefeasibility studies are:
- (i) Delhi-Chandigarh-Amritsar
- (ii) Hyderabad-Dornakal-Vijaywada-Chennai
- (iii) Chennai-Bangalore-Coimbatore-Ernakulam
- (iv) Howrah-Haldia
- (v) Delhi-Agra-Lucknow-Varanasi-Patna
