Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to set up a Centralised database for intelligence integrating databases of various agencies/departments under the Union and State Governments;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Union Government has consulted with all the State Governments in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

- (a) & (b): The Government proposes to set up a Centralized database by integrating the intelligence output relating to terror/terror funding of various agencies/departments under the Union Government.
- (c) to (e): Since no database of State Governments are currently proposed, the question of consulting the State Government does not arise.
