- (b) if so, the airports identified for the same; and
- (c) the total amount allocated for the current financial year for the purpose?

(a): Yes, Madam. Airports Authority of India has planned to raise funds through money market for short term loans and private placement of bonds through capital market for long term loans.

(b) & (c): The details of funds allocated (Rs.in crores) by Airports Authority of India for developments of airports during 2009-10 are as under:

Chennai-467, kolkata-386, Trivandrum-95, Ranchi-20, Raipur-25, Chandigarh-20, Lucknow-30, Ahmedabad-55, Bhopal-26, Indore-22, Madurai-22 and Aeronautical communication-32. Total amount is Rs.1200 Crores.
