The report has been put in the public domain and is available on the website of Oil Industry Safety Directorate (OISD) "http://oisd.nic.in". The Committee, in its report, has determined the causes and critical factors responsible for this incident and has recommended short term as well as long term measures for preventing such incidents. The report of the Committee is under consideration of the Government.
