LOSSES DUE TO IMPORT OF OLD TEXTILES
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Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether domestic textile industry are facing heavy losses due to import of old/inferior textiles from abroad;
- (b) if so, whether it has resulted in heavy losses of foreign exchange also;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to ban the import of old textiles; and
- (d) if so, the details of action being taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SMT. PANABAAKA LAKSHMI)

- (a) & (b): The import of worn clothing/used garments is not in such quantity or value to pose any threat to the domestic textiles industry. The imports of worn clothing in January- September, 2009 was of the order of US\$ 44 million, which is a decline of 2.51% over the corresponding period of the preceding year.
- (c) & (d): The Government has already imposed restrictions on the import of used garments keeping in view the sanitary and phytosanitary issues involved by bringing such imports under the 'Restricted list of Imports' vide Notification No. 7/2004-09 dated the 27th October, 2004.
