Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposals received by the Union Government from the Government of Rajasthan for promoting education in the State during the last two years;
- (b) the number of proposals sanctioned by the Government of Rajasthan;
- (c) the number of proposals pending as on date; and
- (d) the time by which the remaining proposals are likely to be sanctioned?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. D PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (d): As per available information, the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) programme of the Govt. of India is being implemented in Rajasthan for universalization of elementary education. Every year the State sends its Annual Works Plan & Budget (AWP&B) for consideration by the Project Approval Board of SSA. During 2007-08 and 2008-09, an outlay of Rs.159999.35 lakh and Rs. 179803.64 lakh respectively have been sanctioned to Rajasthan under SSA. The sanctioned outlay for 2009-10 is Rs. 224061.71 lakh.

Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education, on the basis of proposals received from the Government of Rajasthan, the Central Government sanctioned Rs.1153.91 lakh for 2007-08 and Rs.840.67 lakh for 2008-09.

Under the scheme of Sub-mission on Polytechnics under Coordinated Action for Skill Development, for establishment of new polytechnics in un-served/ under-served districts, the Rajasthan Government has sent proposals for establishment of polytechnics in 15 Districts. The Polytechnics in all the 15 Districts have already been sanctioned.

The XI Five Year Plan envisages establishment of seven Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) in the Country, out of which one IIM will be set up in Rajasthan.
