Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Union Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Madhya Pradesh to provide financial assistance for upgradation of polytechnic institutes, construction of women hostels and operation of second shift diploma in the State level institutes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be approved?

Answer

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Under the Scheme of 'Sub-Mission on Polytechnics' under Coordinated Action for Skill Development, the State Government of Madhya Pradesh has sent proposals for upgradation of polytechnic institutes, construction of women's hostels and operation of second shift diploma in the state level institutes. The Scheme of operation of second shift diploma in the existing polytechnics has not been approved by the Government. Under the scheme of upgradation of infrastructural facilities, 11 proposals have been approved out of 22 and in the scheme construction of women's hostels in existing polytechnics, 29 proposals out of 47 have been approved during 2009-10.
