APEDA through its Scheme for Infrastructure Development, Scheme for Quality Development, Scheme for Market Development and Scheme for Research & Development has been making efforts to increase exports including that of fruits & vegetables. Government has announced the Scheme of National Horticulture Mission for holistic development of horticulture sector and is providing financial assistance to farmers for taking-up activities to promote horticulture products. The State Governments are also promoting the production of horticulture products.
