TARGETS FOR EXPORTS FROM SEZS AND EOUS

**Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has fixed any target for exports of various goods/items from Special Economic Zones (SEZs) and Export Oriented Zones (EOUs) during the Eleventh Plan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether these targets are being achieved; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor alongwith the steps being taken by the Government to achieve the targets during the above period?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY(SHRI JYOTIRADITYA M. SCINDIA)

(a) to (d): The Government does not fix targets for exports from SEZs/EOUs.

Units in the SEZs are under obligation to achieve positive Net Foreign Exchange (NFE) earnings over a period of 5 years, failing which penalties are leviable. Total exports of Rs. 99,689 crore have been made from SEZs during the financial year 2008-09 registering a growth of 50% over the exports from SEZs for the year 2007-08.
