(a) to (d): Bullet proof jackets (BPJ) are procured on the basis of the requirements of the Army and this is an ongoing process. Further in the light of increased threat perception in counter terrorist operations, a need was felt to review the General Staff Qualitative Requirement (GSQR) of BPJs and the same has been revised accordingly.
