(a) to (e) Train No. 0121/0122 Mumbai - Karwar Holiday Special (Tri -Weekly) was running as holiday special to clear passenger rush. Now regular train service 2133/2134 Mumbai - Karwar -Mumbai Express (Tri-Weekly) has been introduced w.e.f. 21.11.2009. It is proposed to extend the train upto Mangalore, via Kundapur, Udupi. However, there is no proposal at present to run the train daily.
